

Six reasons for bad decisions

- 1)Decision fatigue
- 2)Steady state of distraction
- 3)Lack of input
- 4) Multitasking
- 5)Emotions
- 6)Analysis paralysis





Good Verbiage

• "I will need to gather some information."





Digital Communication

- 1)Not responding when emotions are running high
- 2)Don't comment on a controversial email
- 3)Just don't respond and send a separate email later.





Addressing Behavior

- 1)Be clear on behavior
- 2)State what is/is not allowed
- 3)Fulfill consequences






..... More Good Verbiage
