- Virginia Tech CETL Faculty Teaching Group Grants: The Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CETL), in partnership with the Office of the Executive Vice President and Provost, provides this grant program to support Virginia Tech faculty members who would like to explore a topic related to higher education teaching and learning in a small and interactive learning community. The primary goals of this grant program are 1) to encourage faculty members to form collaborative support networks within or outside of their home departments and colleges at Virginia Tech and 2) to encourage exploration and discovery related to teaching and learning in higher education. Faculty Teaching Groups will receive a grant of up to \$2,000 toward their proposed goals. Approximately five grants will be funded each year. Learn more about the program and grant guidelines.
